After I said goodbye to Teresa, I wondered how the Porsche Club could support them. The need for a new washer and dryer came to mind as I recalled an "Out of Order" sign posted on one machine. The

idea of doing laundry for twelve girls ages 12 to 17 convinced me that this would be a worthwhile benefit. Somehow, I connected clean clothes the children with what Porsche Club members really want for themselves—clean






their support and dedication to the 2014 and 2015 Calendars! Please contact Jack Roberts to order extra calendars.
